## INSTRUCTIONS FOR EDUCATORS

Thank you for downloading this Bible story teaching pack from Godly Pearls ([www.godlypearls.com](http://www.godlypearls.com)). We exist to make Jesus Christ known, one story at a time.

This Bible story teaching pack is titled “God Keeps His Children Safe – A lesson on God’s protection and care for Daniel in the den of lions”. It summarises Daniel’s journey into the den of lions and how he came out unhurt by the lions. We explained that Daniel did not stop praying to God despite the King’s command. He knew the consequence of his action, yet he trusted in God. God was with Daniel even in the den of lions and kept him safe from being hurt by the lions.

The bible references for the story are as follows: Daniel 6:1-23.

We ask that you take the time to prayerfully read the bible references provided and study the materials too. We pray “that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him” (Ephesians 1:17)

We do not take for granted the call and ministry of training kids in a godly way – right from their childhood. Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6).

We do not underestimate the potentials for kids to understand and store God’s word in their hearts from their early age. And that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus (2 Timothy 3:15).

Ultimately, we do not underestimate the power and will of God to bring these children into an enduring relationship with Him. But Jesus said, “Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven” (Matthew 19:14).

This is our desire, hope and joy – that each child might come to experience love and grace in Jesus as they understand His words.

In this Bible story teaching pack, you have the following:

1. Story book/cards.

You will get a book or a pack of large cards depending on how you print yours. This is the section that contains the retelling of the story of Daniel in the den of lions. There are words and pictures to hold the attention of the children.

2. Sequencing flashcards.

Use these cards in a group activity to assess children’s understanding of the story of Daniel in the den of lions. Shuffle the cards, then, ask the group to rearrange the flashcards in the correct order. Don’t forget to shuffle the cards first!

3. Conversation cards

These cards will provide some questions for you to explore with the kids. Encourage them to explore God's protection over them and their families using the questions in these cards. Use these cards in a group activity. You will be amazed at what you find out!

4. Story starter cards

Each of these cards contains a story prompt or beginning sentence and a corresponding picture to help kids retell the story of Daniel in the den of lions in their own words. Use these cards in a group activity. They will feel confident that they can tell the story and even go on to tell their friends and families. Are you a parent? You will enjoy listening to your child retelling this story.

5. Handwriting sheet

A handwriting sheet is provided to be used as individual class, home, or church assignment or to be completed immediately after the study. You get to decide! The lessons will be indirectly emphasized as they trace the words provided.

6. Memory verse and prayer cards

Print these memory verse cards and ask the children to recite them a few times after the study. Then, ask them to take them home, so they can learn to recite the verses during the week. You can quickly ask them to recite the verse before the next study in the following week.

A prayer card is also provided – please use this only as a guide. The end goal is for each child to be able to use their own words while praying to God.

7. Reveal-the-picture game

This game contains some questions or quiz that need to be answered before the children can see the picture underneath the quiz. Print out the picture. Then, print out the quiz sheet and cut out each question along the lines provided. Using a light tape, or an adhesive, paste each question on the picture until the picture is covered. Then, let the children answer the questions randomly and guess what's underneath. The questions are related to the study; thus, you can assess their understanding in this group activity.

8. Crossword puzzle

Print the puzzle to be used as assignment or solved after the study. The answers are included in the puzzle sheet.

9. Maze

Print the maze to be used as assignment or solved after the study.

10. Word search

Print the word search to be used as assignment or solved after the study. The answers are included in the word search sheet.

11. Word scramble

Print the word scramble sheet and get the kids to unscramble the words. A list of words is provided to make this quick, easy, and fun. If you are using

with an older kid, you might want to cut out the word-list section and get them to unscramble the words without using the word-list.

12. Acrostic poem card

This poem card gives older children the opportunity to think deeply about God's protection and what it means as they fill in the words on the card.

13. Learn and colour

Another card aimed at emphasizing the study as kids interact with the pictures and the words.

14. Reward "stickers"

A set of stickers to say, "thank you" and "well done" to the kids for listening and engaging during the study. Print out the sheet, cut out the stickers and use a glue to apply each "sticker" to a child's worksheet when needed.

The instructions are generic to educators, but you know your child/children best; so feel free to adapt the contents as relevant to the different age groups you are in charge of.

We hope you will find these resources useful in your homes, classes, churches, or any other location where you teach children the word of God.

King Darius ruled over a large kingdom in a place called Babylon. He had 120 officers working with him. He also had three special officers helping to make sure everything was going on well in the kingdom.



Daniel worked as a special officer with King Darius. Daniel was excellent at his work. Everything he did was better than the others because God helped him and gave him wisdom.

King Darius really liked the way Daniel worked and wanted to make him the leader of all the officers and the whole kingdom.



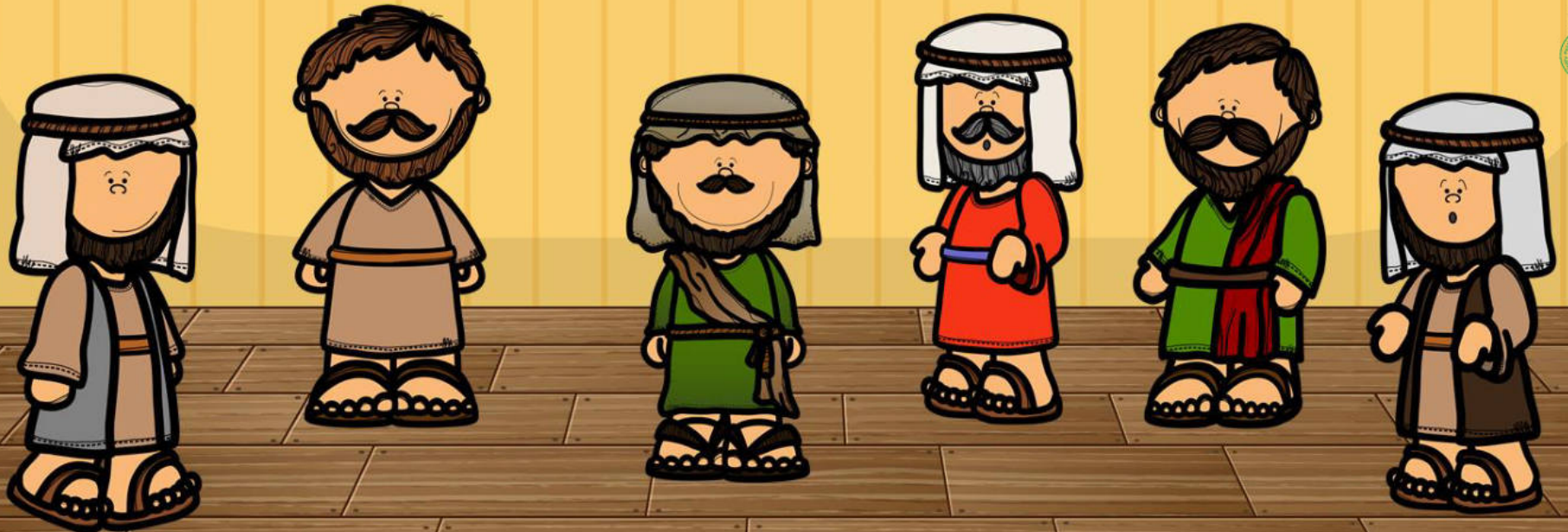
The other officers did not like the idea at all.  
They wanted to stop the king from making Daniel the leader.

So, they began to look for how to make Daniel look bad before King Darius.



They tried and tried to find something to complain about in how Daniel behaved and how he did his work. But they could not find any complaint!

Daniel was so good at everything he did. He was faithful and trustworthy.



Then, they said to one another, "It's so hard to find any complaint against Daniel. How are we going to make him look bad?"

"Oh, I know. We can find a complaint against him by using his belief in his God".

So, all the officers had a meeting to decide on what to do.



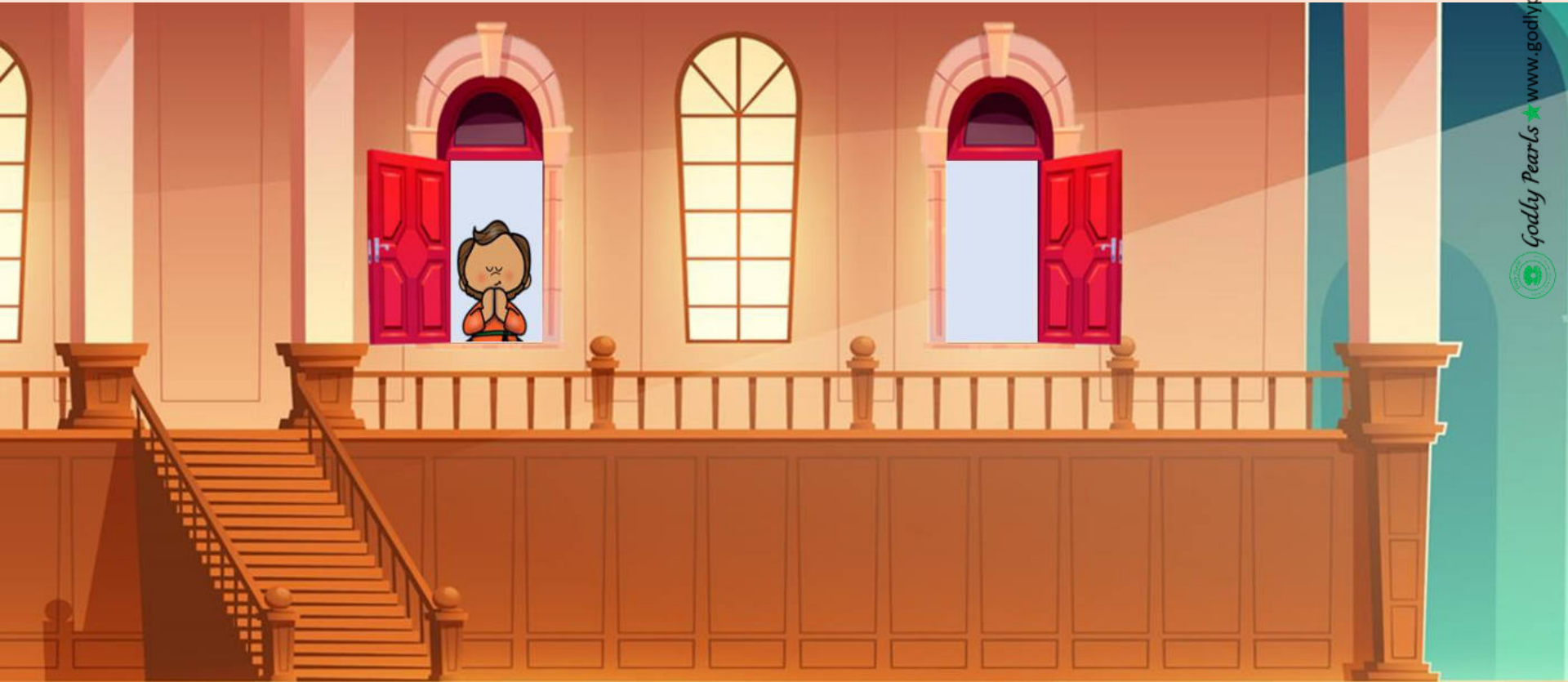
Then, they went to King Darius and said,  
“King Darius, live long! All the officers, counsellors and advisors in this kingdom met together and have written a new law. We would like you to give an order that for the next 30 days, nobody should pray or ask anything from any god or any other man. They can only ask you King Darius. If anybody does not obey this law, they will be thrown into the den of lions”.



The officers then asked the King to sign the new law so that nobody can change it. So, King Darius agreed and signed the law.



Later, Daniel heard that a new law has been signed and that the law meant he cannot pray to his God for the next 30 days. When he heard that, he went to his house, opened his window, knelt down, and prayed to God three times a day.



This was how Daniel prayed every day before the new law was signed.

He was not afraid of the officers or the law!

He was going to continue to pray to God no matter what.



The officers planned to check on Daniel to see if he was going to break the new law. So, they went to Daniel's house and found him praying to God.

Immediately they went to the King to report Daniel.

At last, they found how to make Daniel look bad.

He has broken the King's law!



“Oh King, did you not sign a law that nobody should pray to anyone except you for the next 30 days?”, they asked the King.

“Yes, it is true. The law cannot be changed”, the King replied.

“Well, that man called Daniel does not respect you or the law you have signed. He still prays to God three times a day!”, they complained to the King.



When the King heard that Daniel had broken the law, he became very worried and sad.

He suddenly realised that the officers had deceived him to sign the law so they could make Daniel look bad.

He tried all he could to find a way to save Daniel from going to the den of lions, but he could not.



So at last, the King ordered that Daniel should be thrown into the den of lions.

He told Daniel, "I pray that your God, whom you serve every day, will save you".



When the King got back to the palace, he could not sleep at all throughout the night. He was very worried about Daniel.

So, very early in the morning, the King got out of the palace and hurriedly went to the den of lions.



When he got there, he shouted with pain in his voice, and said, "Daniel, servant of the living God! Was your God, whom you served every day, able to save you from the lions?"

Daniel answered the King, "Long live the King. My God sent his angel to shut the mouth of the lions. The lions did not hurt me because I have not done anything wrong to God and even to you, King Darius". Daniel was alive!



The king was very happy when he heard Daniel's voice!  
He ordered that Daniel should be brought out of the  
den of lions. So, they brought him out.



Daniel was not hurt by the lions. There was not even a scratch on his body.

God protected Daniel and kept him safe in the den of lions because he put his trust in God.
