TITLE: OTHERS MAY.....I CANNOT

CAST

Adrian – the gangster in class (male)

Rex – a classmate (male)

Don – a classmate (male)

Four extra students – two males and two females

A narrator

PROP IDEAS

A classroom scene with six chairs and three tables.

A piece of paper

SCENE 1

(A classroom scene with seven students. Some are seated, while others are standing and chatting to one another. Just then, Adrian walks into the classroom)

Adrian: (He walks into the classroom, looks around, then, shakes the hands of two students. Then, he brings out a piece of paper). Hey, listen up guys! I have got some good news.

(Everyone becomes silent as he speaks, and the students are looking at him)

Adrian: (continues speaking). There is a new roll-on in town! (He gestures with his hand, rolling a piece of paper around his finger and pretending to smoke the rolled paper)

(The four extra students – except Rex and Don – begin to shout in excitement).

The four extra students: (shouts randomly) Tell us about it! We want to know about it! Where can we find it?!

Adrian: Alright, alright, alright! Calm down, calm down. If you want this new roll-on, let me see your hands up.

SCENE 1 CONTD.

(All four students raise their hands – except Rex and Don).

Adrian: OK, be quick. Let's gather outside so I can quickly give you a brief information.

(The students rush out of the class in excitement. Adrian follows them out).

SCENE 2

(Rex and Don remain in class).

Don: (looks over at Rex) I noticed you don't normally join them when they are having these sorts of discussions. Why don't you join them?

Rex: I am a Christian.

Don: I am also a Christian. And I don't see anything wrong with having a good time with my classmates.

Rex: That's not what I mean. Of course, I love my classmates and can have a good time with them when it does not go against what God says and what God wants me to do.

Don: I don't understand you. What do you mean?

Rex: Well, for example, Adrian is trying to get everyone into smoking the new roll-on in town. I can't join them in such conversations and can't smoke with them because God would not want me to put that smoke in my body.

Don: Why not? I smoke from time to time. But I usually control myself.

Rex: The bible makes me to understand that my body is a dwelling place for the Holy Spirit. It means the Holy Spirit lives in me, so, I cannot make my body dirty and polluted for Him to live in.

If you were expecting a very important person to stay in your house, you would make the place neat and comfortable for him or her to stay, wouldn't you? How much more when we are talking about the Holy Spirit?

SCENE 2 CONTD.

Don: Wow, I didn't see it that way. I thought I could do anything I wanted with my body, even though I am a Christian.

Rex: Not exactly. As Christians, our bodies are not our own anymore. They belong to God. We were bought with the blood of Jesus, so, we cannot claim that it is our body. Our bodies and everything about us belong to God.

Don: I think I understand your point. I admire you a lot. You are so bold and courageous. I think I am always worried about what other people would say about my choices. So, I always do what will make people around me happy rather than what would make God happy. I truly want to be able to stand for Jesus like you do – even if I am the only one standing.

Rex: You can. If you ask God for courage, boldness, and strength, He will give you. He will help you to always choose what will make Him happy rather than what would make other people happy.

Don: Do you mind praying with me please?

Rex: I don't mind. I am happy to pray with you. (Rex holds Don's hands) Let us pray together.

(The two pray silently as the narrator concludes the story).

Narrator: "Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore, glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's (1 Corinthians 6:19-20).

SCENE 2 CONTD.

Narrator continues: Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols?

For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people." Therefore "come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty" (2 Corinthians 6:14-18).
