**TITLE:** THE FRIENDSHIP BENCH

## CAST

Ruth – Sandra’s friend; attends same school (female)  
Sandra – Ruth’s friend; attends same school, very kind (female)  
Lynda – a schoolmate (female)  
A narrator

## PROP IDEAS

A bench

## SCENE 1

(Narrator: Two friends – Ruth and Sandra – walk past a bench at school called the friendship bench. Ruth starts to laugh at a young girl who is sitting on the bench)

Sandra: (faces Ruth) Why are you laughing?

Ruth: (points to a young girl sitting on the bench).

Lynda: (the young girl bows her head in shame)

Sandra: (looks surprised at Ruth) I don’t see why you are laughing, Ruth. Does she look funny? Or don’t you know what the friendship bench is for?

Ruth: Of course, I do! The friendship bench is for people who find it difficult to make friends because they are so ugly, poor, and miserable.

Sandra: No, not at all. I’ll tell you. The friendship bench is for people who might be shy but want to make friends. They just need someone to say hello and maybe talk to them.

Ruth: Well, why would anyone want to talk to her?

Sandra: I can't tell you exactly why but it's the right thing to do. I'm going to talk to her.

## SCENE 1 CONTD.

Ruth: You can't be serious!

Sandra: I am serious.

(By this time, they had already walked past the friendship bench. So, Sandra turned to go back. Ruth pulled Sandra's arms, but Sandra pulled back her arm and walked towards the young girl).

Sandra: (Sandra turns to face Ruth) Just stop being mean. I bet she's a lovely girl. But you won't know that if you don't take the time to find out by getting to know her.

(Sandra walks towards the girl. Ruth walks away).

## SCENE 2

(Narrator: As Sandra walks to meet the young girl on the friendship bench, she raised her head to look at Sandra – not sure of what might happen).

Sandra: Hello, my name is Sandra (Sandra smiled).

Lynda: (Lynda smiles back). Hello, my name is Lynda.

Sandra: Can I sit beside you?

Lynda: Yes, sure.

Sandra: Thank you (she sits). I see you are alone here.

Lynda: Well, not anymore because you are here with me now.

Sandra: Ah, you must be very funny.

(The two laugh together).

Sandra: So, what subject do you like best?

Lynda: I like Literature. I love to read novels a lot. I hope to become a writer someday.

## SCENE 2 CONTD.

**Sandra:** Wow, really? That's so cool! Are you currently reading any novel?

**Lynda:** Yes. The title is "Don't call me at night".

**Sandra:** Wow, really? Do you know a friend gave me that novel last year for my birthday?

**Lynda:** Wow! Have you finished reading it?

**Sandra:** No, not yet. I am so slow with reading.

**Lynda:** How about if we read it together?

**Sandra:** Yes, that's a good idea!

(A brief silence)

**Lynda:** Can I ask you a question?

**Sandra:** Yes, sure

**Lynda:** You seem so nice and kind. Why are you so nice to me?

**Sandra:** You see, I am a friend of Jesus. Jesus teaches me to be nice, kind and loving to everyone.

**Lynda:** I see. I have heard about Jesus, but I don't think I am His friend. Can I become His friend too?

**Sandra:** Yes, you can! He loves you and wants you to be His friend too.

(The two continue talking as the narrator concludes the story).

**Narrator:** “My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality. For if there should come into your assembly a man with gold rings, in fine apparel, and there should also come in a poor man in filthy clothes, and you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, “You sit here in a good place,” and say to the poor man, “You stand there,” or, “Sit here at my footstool,” have you not shown partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts? (James 2:1-4)

For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: “You shall love your neighbour as yourself.” (Galatians 5:14).
