TITLE: MEET MY FRIEND

CAST

Abigail – Sandra’s friend
Sandra – Abigail’s friend
Lizzy – a stranger at the park
A Narrator.

PROP IDEAS

A park scene.
A park bench.

SCENE 1

(Abigail and Sandra are at the park. Lizzy is also walking around the park, slowly, looking worried, disturbed, absent-minded etc.)

Sandra: It’s a beautiful day!

Abigail: Yes, it’s such a blessing to enjoy God’s creation.

Sandra: I hope you have not forgotten our volleyball practice this weekend? Will you be able to make it?

Abigail: Yes, I will be around. I won’t be going to work this weekend. (Abigail looks at a lady (Lizzy) in a distance who looks a bit worried)

Sandra: Tomorrow, I would like to get some.....

Abigail: Have you noticed that young lady over there?

SCENE 1 CONTD.

Sandra: Where?

Abigail: Under that tree (points to a tree where Lizzy is now sitting down). Excuse me Sandra, I need to go and speak with her briefly. I'll be back, OK? (Abigail walks towards Lizzy).

Sandra: No worries, Abigail. I'll just wait here for you.

SCENE 2

(Abigail walks towards Lizzy. Lizzy stands and leans on the tree, looking depressed).

Abigail: Hello, are you OK? (Abigail calls out to Lizzy).

Lizzy: (sighs). I will be honest with you. I am not OK. I need help.

(Abigail leads Lizzy to a nearby seat and they both sat down).

Abigail: You can talk to me. What's happening with you?

Lizzy: I am slowly losing everything in my life. My job.... Some of my friends no longer want me around them.

Abigail: And why is that?

Lizzy: I have been struggling to break free from smoking, drinking, using hard drugs, and gambling. I try and become sober for a few weeks and go right back into the habits again. I am so scared of losing my job as I have been performing badly and given several warnings. My family has been trying hard to put up with me. I know they feel embarrassed by my lifestyle (She looks at Abigail as if expecting an answer). I am desperate. I need help!

Abigail: (she closes her eyes, looks up and sighs). I have a friend that can help you. His name is Jesus. He died on the cross, so you don't have to struggle with these addictions anymore. If you give him your struggles, He will give you the peace, joy, and freedom you so much desire.

(Abigail turns to Lizzy).

SCENE 2 CONTD.

Abigail: Have you heard about Jesus?

Lizzy: Yes, but I have not given religion much thought.

Abigail: Jesus is not just a religious figure. He loves you and wants you to have a personal relationship with Him. He wants to be Your friend. If you allow Him into your life, He will make all the difference.

Lizzy: You sound so convincing.... how can you be so sure?

Abigail: I know because I have been where you are. I have experienced shame, rejection, addiction and almost committed suicide. When I thought all hope was lost, Jesus rescued me. He found me and filled me with His love. He forgave me all that I have ever done and gave me a fresh start.

Lizzy: A fresh start? I would really love to start all over again.

Abigail: Let me give you two verses from the bible (opens the verse from her phone) This is Romans 10:13. For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.” Let’s back up to Romans 10:10. It says, “For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation”. Do you believe?

Lizzy: Yes, I believe.

Abigail: Can I pray with you?

Lizzy: Yes, please!

Abigail: (prays with Lizzy).

Lizzy: Thanks so much for that. I feel so much better listening to those words you spoke to me.

Abigail: Yes, the word of God gives us life. There’s so much God has prepared for us. You will find that the bible is full of treasures when you start reading it.

Lizzy: I can’t wait to read the bible for myself. What’s your name by the way? Mine is Lizzy.
