CAST

Beatrice – a female, Mariam’s friend.
Mariam – a female, Beatrice’s friend.
A narrator.

PROP IDEAS

One table
Two chairs
Two plates of food with spoons/forks
Two cups of water

SCENE 1

(Narrator: It is a dining room setting. Beatrice and Mariam are having lunch and chatting as they ate their meals)

Beatrice: (looks up at Mariam). Thank you for inviting me over for lunch at your house. (A pause) This food is delicious.

Mariam: (smiles). Why, thank you! I haven’t seen you in a long time and I just wanted to catch up with you. We haven’t had our prayer meeting for some time too; so, looking forward to today’s prayers after our lunch.

Beatrice: I agree, it’s been a while. Were you at last week’s prayer meeting in church?

Mariam: No, I couldn’t attend in person, but I joined online.

Beatrice: Why?

Mariam: Oh, I returned late from work.

Beatrice: Are you sure you were not busy chatting with Mr. Right and briefly forgot about the prayer meeting like you did last time.

SCENE 1 CONTD.

Mariam: (laughs) No, not at all. My manager wanted me to complete an urgent task before closing for the day.

Beatrice: Well, I was just teasing you. That reminds me ... did you hear about Dan and Debby's wedding?

Mariam: They are getting married for real? When was it announced?

Beatrice: During the prayer meeting. I thought you said you attended online?

Mariam: Oh, I joined a bit late, so, I must have missed that part of the meeting. Anyways, I'm happy for them.

Beatrice: (shakes her head) I feel sorry for Esther. After all she did to get Dan's attention and marry him. She wasn't even the best choice.

Mariam: You don't know that for sure.

Beatrice: Of course, it's true. That's what Sheila told me. And for Rachael. I hope she won't end up getting dumped like Esther. Rachael has been trying hard to get Sam.

Mariam: Hmm, I don't believe that!

Beatrice: Of course, it's true. That's what Sheila told me.

Mariam: Sheila again? Where does she get this news from?

Beatrice: Sheila, powerful intel! Are you aware that Rob has broken up with Pat?

Mariam: Really?

Beatrice: Yes, and I am not surprised. I knew they wouldn't last longer than six months.

Mariam: How did you know that? Sheila again?

Beatrice: No, I just knew it. Pat is too arrogant, and Rob does not look romantic at all. He is not the type of man that I would want to marry.

Mariam: (puts her palms to her face) Er ... Beatrice, I am getting uncomfortable with this conversation. Can we talk about something else?

Mariam: (shakes her head) If it's gossiping about other people, I am no longer interested. I don't want to hear it.

Beatrice: Who is gossiping? We are just sharing, that's all. We can even pray for them, you know.

Mariam: (looks amused and surprised) Hmm, pray for them. (A pause) Let's take these plates to the sink so I'll quickly wash them.

(Mariam and Beatrice exit the stage).

Narrator: Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. Ephesians 4:29.
