- 5 When Naomi returned to Bethlehem, what did she ask people to call her?

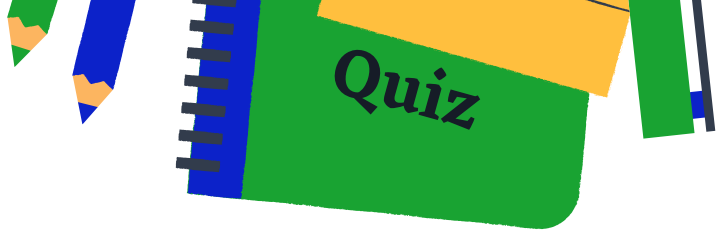
- 6 When Naomi and Ruth returned to Bethlehem, the people were very sad to see them. True or False?
