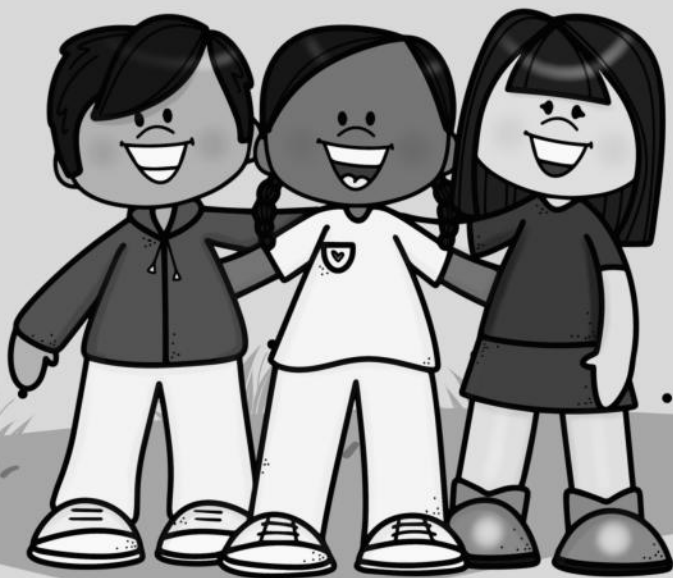

“Give the crowd to eat,” he said.



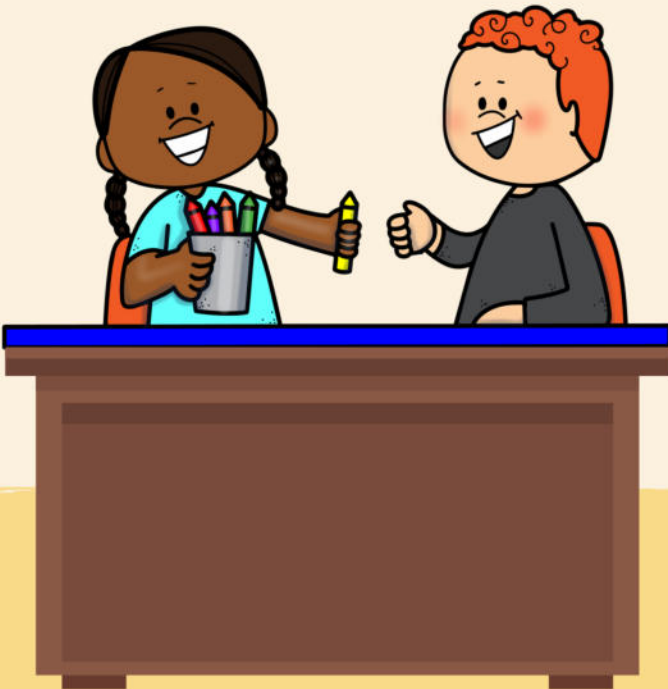
Everyone got something to eat.

No shouting, just waiting.




I can let someone know,
