God listens to you



OBJECT:

A phone



What to do:

1. Show the children a phone.
2. Ask a question. For example, what is this? What can you do with a phone?



Read the Bible References: The Bible references can be read by different children if possible. Or the teacher can read them.



Goals of Lesson:

1. To encourage children to talk to God at all times
2. To reassure children that God is listening to them

GOD LISTENS TO

Bible References:

Jeremiah 29:12;

Psalm 50:15; Psalm 91:15-16



Notes

God loves you and He wants you to spend time with Him. One of the ways you can spend time with God is by talking to Him. You can talk to God when you call Him. You cannot use a phone to talk to God, but you can use your mouth and heart. Another word for talking to God is prayer.

When you pray or talk to God, He hears you. When you pray, you open our mouth and speak to God; you also focus your heart on what you are saying to God.

Let us discuss some people who called God in the bible.

In the book of Daniel 6:10, 21-23, King Darius made a new law that no one should pray to any other god or man for thirty days except to the King. Daniel knew that it was a bad law, so he called on God. He was thrown into the den of lions, but God sent an angel to save him.

He was not hurt, and he came out alive.

Notes continued:

In the book of 1 Samuel 1:26-27, Hannah did not have a child and she wanted one. She called on God and asked Him to give her a son. God heard Hannah's prayer and gave her a son named Samuel.

Let's look at the book of Acts 16:23-31. Paul and Silas were thrown into prison because they would not stop telling people about the good news. When they were in the prison, they called on God. They prayed and sang songs to God. Then, there was a great earthquake, their chains fell off their hands and they were free.

God is everywhere and He can hear when you call on His name even when no one else is there with you. Maybe you feel alone at school or in your room at home, do you know you can talk to God and ask Him to fill your heart with His love and peace?

Paul and Silas were chained in the prison, but when they called on God, He heard them and saved them. When Hannah prayed, she did not even speak out loud, she prayed silently in her heart, but God knew exactly what she wanted and answered her.

Daniel was in the den of lions and in danger. God heard him. He knew exactly where Daniel was and sent an angel to save him. God knows you. He knows exactly where you are. He knows exactly what you need. So, when you talk to Him about what you need, He hears you.

You can talk to God about anything. He does not chase you away when you call Him. He wants to hear from you. You can talk to God about your friends, mum, dad, brothers, sisters, school assignment, anything you need etc.

And do you know you can also talk to God when you don't have anything to ask for? You can just tell Him how much you love Him. You can say thanks to Him for loving you so much. You can thank Him for keeping you alive every day, giving you a lovely family, wonderful friends, clothes to wear, food to eat, a house to live in and many more good things He has done for you. You can sing songs to praise God. You can play a musical instrument to praise God – just like King David did.



Memorize:

Romans 10:13 - For whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.



Questions:

- i. From our study today, mention three people who called on God.
- ii. What can you talk to God about?

You can use a phone to call your friends and families or anyone you want to talk to. Remember that you can talk to God at anytime and He will listen to you.
